What's New

Line 3a has been modified to clarify how a disregarded entity completes this line. An LLC that is a disregarded entity should check the appropriate box for the tax classification of its owner. Otherwise, it should check the "LLC" box and enter its appropriate tax classification.

New line 3b has been added to this form. A flow-through entity is required to complete this line to indicate that it has direct or indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries when it provides the Form W-9 to another flow-through entity in which it has an ownership interest. This change is intended to provide a flow-through entity with information regarding the status of its indirect foreign partners, owners, or beneficiaries, so that it can satisfy any applicable reporting requirements. For example, a partnership that has any indirect foreign partners may be required to complete Schedules K-2 and K-3. See the Partnership Instructions for Schedules K-2 and K-3 (Form 1065).

DISTRICT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

TAOS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

I, the undersigned cooperator, have been informed of the purpose of the TAOS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT, its objectives and program. I desire to use my land within its capabilities to treat it according to its needs. To this end, therefore, I enter into the following agreement with the above-mentioned TAOS SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT.

I AGREE:

1. To develop, as rapidly as feasible, with the assistance of the District, a conservation plan for my operating unit that will be mutually acceptable to me and the District.
2. To carry out such a mutually acceptable plan as rapidly as my resources and the help available to me from the District will permit.
3. To comply, in carrying out the conservation plan, with any applicable State laws governing the beneficial use of water.
4. To maintain all necessary structures and other needed conservation measures which the District has helped me put into effect on my unit.
5. To furnish authority for the application of any part of the conservation plan, where such authority is necessary.

THE DISTRICT AGREES:

1. To furnish a soil survey and other necessary resource inventories of the cooperator's operating unit.
2. To provide available technical assistance to help prepare and carry out the conservation plan for the cooperator's operating unit.
3. To furnish, within the provisions of the conservation plan, such equipment and materials as are available from the District and as are requested by the cooperator for carrying out the conservation plan.
4. To maintain confidentiality of the conservation plan.

IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED:

1. That, in the event of the sale of the operating unit, neither the cooperator nor the new owner will be obligated to carry out the provisions of this agreement. However, the cooperator agrees to inform the new owner of the existing conservation plan for the unit and to advise him of assistance he may receive from the District in connection with the plan.
2. The availability of technical assistance will be dependent upon the resources of the District.

This agreement will become effective on the date of the last signature and may be terminated by mutual agreement of the parties hereto.

WHEREAS, Taos SWCD has recommended that User retain the services of licensed professionals to perform the work on the Project, but User has elected to self-perform the work on the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, I/We ("User"), _____, hereby agree to follow all instructions and guidelines provided by Taos SWCD and abide by all rules and regulations provided by same to complete this project. This includes all specifications provided by Taos SWCD for the construction of the Project. User also agrees to abide by all other pertinent federal, state and local regulations, including all safety guidelines, rules and regulations, including, but not limited to, traffic safety, work site safety, etc.

Prior to commencing work on the project User must submit a work plan and inspection schedule to Taos SWCD for approval. If the project is located on property not owned by User applicable permits, approvals, leases, and/or easements must be obtained and copies delivered to Taos SWCD prior to performing work on the Project.

User shall be solely responsible for the actions of any contractors hired by User to perform the work on the Project. Should User complete or participate in the Project, User understands the hazards of using methods, tools and equipment associated with Acequia restoration projects, including, but not limited to the use of heavy equipment and tools.

By signing this agreement, User releases and agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Taos SWCD, its supervisors, staff, technical agents, and/or representatives against and from any and all damage, loss, claims, and liabilities arising as a result of the Project. Such agreement to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Taos SWCD shall include in addition all claims from other property owners and any third parties.

User understands and accepts that the Project may be stopped or modified at any time due to negative impacts on natural resources, adverse weather and/or other restrictions.

User understands and agrees that failure to comply with the guidelines for this Project may result in the User having to reimburse Taos SWCD any and all cost-share funds paid to the User for the Project.

All equipment of Taos SWCD used will be inspected before being released and will be inspected again when returned. User's obligation to hold harmless, defend and indemnify Taos SWCD shall specifically include claims arising out of the use of any equipment of Taos SWCD.
